Nevada showing progress but still below national average. (links ?) -finalized Medicaid Managed Care Organization breast pump benefits sheet; four MCOs offer breast pumps at no cost under Nevada Medicaid. (links ?) 	
ARPA Grant Update	Cristina	<p>-awarded third cycle of scholarships; recipients announced weekly via coalition social media.</p> <p>-latch clinic launched at UNLV Pediatrics.</p> <p>-Spanish Breastfeeding Support Group moved to Thursdays (9–10:30 am) at Anthem Wellness Center</p> <p>-another latch clinic planned at HLI, mid-October.</p> <p> The Nevada Lactation Hub Scholarship Program is a collaborative effort between the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) and The Nevada Breastfeeding Coalition (NVBC) that will increase and diversify the next-generation lactation support providers in Nevada through November 2026. This project is being supported by federal allocation number SLFRP2634 allocated to the State of Nevada by the U.S. Department of the Treasury through a subward to the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (#SG 2024-00407, PI: Dr. Gabriela Buccini)</p> <p> This year we have made several wonderful partnerships including Nourish Nevada, Renown Hospital, NVMCH, Anthem Wellness Center, UNLV Pediatric Clinic, & The Healthy Living Institute. There are several barriers to becoming a lactation specialist and a board certified lactation consultant. This grant aims to help reduce those barriers and help future programs do the same.</p> <p> The grant has two components. To award 70 scholarships for people in NV who would like to become a lactation specialist. The second component is for 10 people who are on the path to become IBCLCs. This program is for those on the pathway 3 program by including chief mentors, and provides paid hours.</p>
